STATUTE OF THE BEST YOUNG SCIENTIST'S PRESENTATION AWARDS

at the International Conference on Computer Recognition Systems CORES 20007

- 1. The awards will be conferred for the three best presentations of the papers, given by young scientists. The recipients of the award will be the persons presenting the papers.
- 2. The awards will be conferred by the Scientific Committee of the Conference on the basis of the scientific merit of the papers and the quality of the presentations.
- 3. The young scientists giving oral presentations as well as poster presentations are candidates to the awards.
- 4. The awards will be chosen by the Laureates, in the sequence according to the level of the award, from among the following:
 - 1. A book: I. N. Bankman (Ed.). *Handbook of Medical Imaging, Processing and Analysis*. Acadamic Press 2000.
 - 2. A book: K. Ramesh. *Digital Photoelasticity*. *Advanced Techniques and Applications*. Springer 2000
 - 3. An arbitrary scientific book of the value up to 100 euro, chosen by the Laureate.
 - 4. An arbitrary scientific book of the value up to 70 euro, chosen by the Laureate.

Each of the awards will be complemented with a diploma and a dedication.

5. The awards will be conferred during the closing of the Conference.
